The 2 positive staff members are currently isolating at home.

Additionally, a member of our care team in the health care center also tested positive. Thankfully this coworker had not worked during the infectious period and as a result, this will not impact our care units.

On a positive note, we received new guidance from our regulatory agencies for our health care center and assisted lifestyles community related to our fully vaccinated residents. Fully vaccinated residents may now dine and participate in activities without face coverings or social distancing if all participating residents are fully vaccinated. This is wonderful news and today we are celebrating the many smiling faces. We are so happy to be able to see them again!
