Dear Residents and Families,

I hope this letter finds you all well. Memorial Day weekend is upon us and as we all prepare to spend time with friends and family, we also take time to honor the brave military men and women who lost their lives fighting for our freedom. I want to extend my gratitude to all who have served our country so that we may enjoy the freedoms we have today.

Last week I shared with you the news that 2 of our coworkers and 1 resident from our health care center had tested positive for COVID. I am pleased to report that after several rounds of testing, there are no other cases on our campus. The coworkers and resident who were affected are doing well and only experienced mild symptoms.

The Pennsylvania Department of Health regulations require temporary restrictions to visitation, and isolation precautions any time there is a positive case of COVID-19 within our health care center. We are scheduled to resume our reopening progress on Monday, May 31, 2021.

I share with you below a brief update of reopening activity for each level of care on our campus.

### ***Health Care Center***

#### **Springfield Unit:**

We are pleased to report that the resident who tested positive had only mild symptoms and is expected to have a complete recovery.

The staff member that tested positive has recovered and will return to work later this week.

Our Springfield unit will be open for scheduled visits beginning Monday, May 31, 2021 if we continue to have no positive cases. Residents will resume group activities and dining.



**Countryside Halls 2 and 3:**

I am happy to report that our Countryside halls 2 and 3 will reopen on Monday, May 31 2021. Scheduled visits will resume and residents will again enjoy group dining and activities.

The coworker who had tested positive has recovered and will return to work later this week.

**Countryside Hall 1, Tenley Rehabilitation Unit and Waterside Units:**

These units remain COVID free and will continue with dining and activities without restrictions.

***Assisted Lifestyle***

Our Assisted Lifestyle community continues to be free of COVID. We are progressing with our reopening plans. Fully vaccinated residents may have group activities and dine together without masks or physical distancing as long as everyone is fully vaccinated; masks and physical distancing are required under all other circumstances. Unvaccinated residents must continue to physically distance and wear a mask.

***Independent Living***

Our independent living section of our campus is fully reopened following the latest CDC guidance. Residents are able to enjoy all the services and amenities we have to offer.
