I pray you are all doing well as we approach the weeks ahead with hope and anticipation that we will be able to re-open all areas of our campus in the coming weeks. Though this has been a challenging time, we have much to celebrate. As of today, our baseline COVID-19 testing for coworkers and residents have all come back negative, and as a result, our Health Care Center can begin reopening steps!

Our Health Care Center has entered Step 1 of reopening and if all goes well, we will move into Step 2 on July 26, 2020. In Step 2 we will be permitted to offer expanded outdoor visitation and small group activities. We have posted the plan on our website for your review. If our county stays in Pennsylvania's green phase of reopening and we continue to have no cases of COVID-19 in our Health Care Center, we will move to Step 3 in August.

We have completed the COVID-19 baseline testing for our Assisted Lifestyle and Waterside Memory Care communities. All Waterside resident and co-worker tests were negative! We anticipate results on the Assisted Lifestyle residents at the end of this week; however the laboratories are becoming overwhelmed with the increase in volume.

On Friday, July 10, 2020 our Independent Living community moved into Phase 4 of their reopening plan. Though this was an exciting step, Governor Wolf has now required reduced occupancy for indoor activities such as dining. Because of this, we will need to maintain a reduced occupancy of 25 or less for all indoor activities. Thankfully our groups are typically fewer than 25 people to allow for social distancing. Everyone is doing a wonderful job of maintaining safe distances, wearing masks and sanitizing their hands!

I ask for your continued prayers for our community through the reopening process. As we carefully resume activities and begin to reunite with family and friends, I am extremely thankful to all of you for your support and patience.
